Warrior Sailing

If you know a veteran that you think could benefit from facing a new challenge on the water, please check out the warrior sailing program. No prior experience is required. They hold a series of classes during the year and participate in races like the ones that will be held at the Annapolis Yacht Club in October. According to Jen French, the founder of Warrior Sailing, "Military veterans and active duty personnel who have been diagnosed with a disability are welcome to participate in the Warrior Sailing Program. Among the 250 participants about 75 percent suffer from post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) or some type of brain injury. Participants range in age from 19 to 80." In a news article announcing the event at Annapolis, French stated, "We're not just taking them for boat rides. We're teaching them the sport of sailing.
